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1. Course Description

Museum education is an educational activity conducted inside and outside the museum. It goes without saying that the museum's main functions include exhibitions, preservation, and utilization, all of which are linked to museum education, but in recent years, museums have been making major changes in policy through erudite collaboration, and many newly established museums have placed museum education at the center of museum activities.
