# 1. 授業の概要(ねらい)

This class provides students with an opportunity to plan and give their presentations in English based on the skills obtained in their 3rd year. Through a variety of activities that involve pair and group work, students have chances to demonstrate their proficiency in presentations on social, political, economic problems, and global issues that affect the whole world.

- (2) Create and deliver effective presentations about domestic and global issues
- (3) Ask questions and participate actively in discussions related to a presentation topic
- (4) Evaluate a presentation according to objective criterion, and learn from each other's presentation skills
