1. Course Description

The professor teaching this course has had a great deal of experience as a senior officer in both the central and local governments, such as diplomat, deputy mayor, administrative manager and as a pioneer of the "One village one product movement" (a typical policy for local development, spreading throughout Japan). The professor also holds the title of the honorary professor at the Local Autonomy College, Ministry of Internal Affairs and Communications.
