Practice of Teaching

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1. Course Description

The aim of this course is to help students acquire basic knowledge and skills in teaching by observing and participating in educational practice in school. It also enhances the clarification of student's aptitude and tasks for teaching.

2. Course Objectives

The goals of this course are to

- (1) be able to understand the characteristics of students and educational activities at a school on teaching practice.
- (2) be able to observe student's behavior in the class, record it according to the facts, and reflect on your teaching practices using these records.
- (3) be able to prepare instruction plans and practice lessons using basic teaching skills.
- (4) be able to understand the role of classroom teacher and help to manage the classroom.
