1. Course Description

Objectives of the Period for Integrated Studies are to enable junior and senior high students to think in their own way about life through cross-synthetic studies and inquiry studies, while fostering the qualities and abilities needed to find their own tasks, to make proactive decisions and to solve problems better. Extra-curricular Activities are also important learning for junior and senior high students to develop their own personalities and social skills through the activities of the classroom, student's association, and school events.

- (9) Understand the importance of cooperation with households / local residents and related organizations in extracurricular activities.
